Generous Giving Appeal. In January I gave an update regarding the responses we had received following the Generous Giving Appeal, October 2024. Most of those who replied and were able to increase their amount that they regularly give to the Church have now done so. Some have managed to increase by more than they said, and some others have increased, but did not respond. We have had 13 existing regular donors and 6 new donors who between them have increased their regular donations to the Church by £252, although we have also had 2 donors who have decided they can no longer make regular donations, so we have lost £52. Our regular donations have increased by £200 per month which equates to just over an increase of 3% per month.

Thank you to all these people for their increases. If your circumstances change at any time during the year, you can amend your donation (you do not have to wait until we run an appeal).
