Revision of the Electoral Roll In preparation for the APCM on Sunday 28th April, the annual revision of the Electoral Roll will take place between 30th March and 13th April. This means that new names can be added to/removed from the Electoral Roll up to and including 13th April. After that date no new names can be added until after the APCM. If you are new to St Andrew's and would like to be added to the Electoral Roll, please let me know and I will give you a form. *Those eligible mist have been baptised and be over the age of 16 years

*They must live in the parish of Biggleswade. Alternatively, if living outside the parish, should have worshipped at St Andrew's habitually during the past six months
