Youth Discipleship

Our dream is to raise up a generation who love Jesus, are committed to their families, belong to a local church, are generous to the poor and are positive role model in their communities. This is done through activities like youth discipleship programmes, youth leader exchange visits, youth camps and community-based youth groups.



Under 5s

Recognising that a significant amount of a child's development happens between the ages of zero to five, Hands at Work is developing facilities and programming for children under the age of five at Care Points. This includes a simple, repetitive and tailored program incorporating breakfast, play, rest time, and learning basic skills – all while their older siblings are in school.



Community Gardens

Our dream is to continually build resiliency in our Care Workers, the most vulnerable children and their families, so that when challenges come, they are better equipped to stand. One way that this is done is through the provision of community gardens, enabling greater support and sustainability for whole families.



Church Mobilisation

Central to our vision is seeing the local church actively involved in caring for the most vulnerable children within their own communities. Through church mobilisation, Maranatha Workshops and Hands at Work's foundations training, we are committed to helping our church leaders grow in their understanding of the Biblical mandate to care for the most vulnerable.



African Leadership Development

We are committed to continually investing into and raising up African leaders, who love Jesus and long to be a part of His calling to serve the most vulnerable. This is done through intentional discipleship, regular exchange visits and the addition of new team members.



Projects

We are committed to the safety and security of the most vulnerable children in their own homes as well as at the Life Centre. Projects including regular home repairs and upgrades to facilities including toilets, cooking shelters, shade structures and play areas help to strengthen communities towards greater sustainability.
